Applicants should be musically qualified in playing the organ either through qualification or through demonstrable experience, have a wide knowledge of varying styles of music and have experience in working with amateur choirs. Previous church organist experience would be an advantage but is not essential. Experience of playing other instruments is also desirable but not essential.

Interview candidates will be asked to play the Church organ and keyboard as part of the interview process and should therefore prepare a short piece to demonstrate their technical ability. Sight reading of a standard piece of Church music will also be required.
